Types of Radios and Headsets

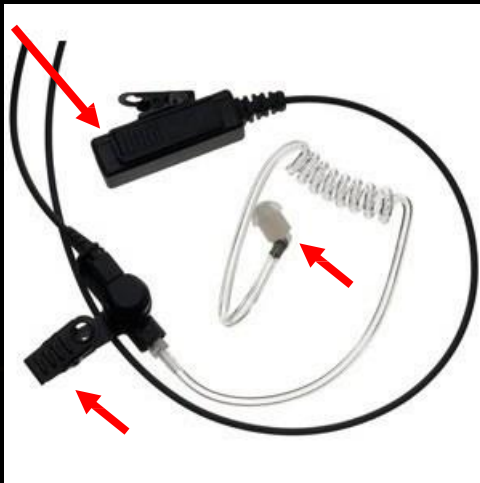
- Midland is the best named brand
- Must be predominantly Black
- Must clip to your belt





Headsets –

- I prefer the in ear model with the separate mic
- Should have a collar clip for comfort



PRE-GAME SET UP

- Check operation and verify Batteries are fully charged
 - Bring extra batteries
- Suggested the R have extra radio for ECO
- Run wires under shirt
- Choose the channel to start with and a know “switch to channel B, C and D”
- Example - start with 4 – B is channel 8 – C is Channel 16 – etc....
- What will be discussed on radio – it is an open line
 - NO BS'ing on the Radio
- Cut the unnecessary chatter
 - It is annoying!!!





WHAT TO USE IT FOR.

- Referee should set the tone for the radio
- Communicate any necessary info
 - 12 or 10 on field – Not every count
 - Hold the Kickoff
- Penalties – but don't look lazy
 - Push button – pause – foul – team – number – result of the play
 - Be ready to repeat if R needs it
 - Wings (short and Deep) communicate with sidelines
 - Get selection from coaches
 - Umpire and H mark off together when ready
 - If R has mic – help if needed

COMMUNICATION TOOL

- Use this as a tool to speed up the game – but not hurry
- Don't look lazy using this tool
- If any long discussion is needed – run in to discuss
